## History of *Chic*

*Chic*, a short-lived weekly published in New York in 1880-1881, featured sophisticated wit and colored lithographs drawn by Charles Kendrick, who contributed heavily to *Life* and *Puck*, but the lithographs are less garish than those by Oppen and Gillam and by virtue of their subject matter—conditions in the theater, fashionable excesses—appealed to an audience that was on the whole more interested in society and the arts than in politics.
