## **Join Building People Power (BPP) in our people driven fight to achieve racial and social justice.** Here's how you can get involved:

- **Join an Issue Campaigns:** Advocate for and against policies and practices related to the five BPP Issue Areas: Health, Housing, Education, Economics, and Criminal Justice. Issue Campaigns identify a specific policy goal and use collaborative and direct action to enact change.
- **Become a District Advocate:** Serve as citizen lobbyists by communicating and building relationships with decision-makers (e.g. elected officials), sharing action alerts with volunteers, and attending quarterly training.
- **Join a local Action Team:** Action Team's are civic groups that help connect residents to social and racial justice work happening in their community. There is a Wilmington Action Team, Rt. 9 Action Team, Dover Action Team, and Middletown-Odessa-Townsend Action Team.
