He is best known for *Indigenous Faces of Wilmington*, a compelling photographic exhibition presented at the Delaware Art Museum that highlights the presence, diversity, and contemporary lives of Indigenous people living in Wilmington, Delaware. The project reflects Andre's commitment to visibility, representation, and storytelling through an Indigenous lens.

With a background spanning brand photography, documentary work, and commercial projects, Andre has documented major cultural moments, including the Delaware Art Museum's Hip-Hop Cultural Summit and events featuring influential figures in hip-hop history. Whether working with magazines, nonprofits, artists, or local businesses, his process remains consistent: build trust, honor the story, and create images with intention and purpose. Through photography and filmmaking, Andre continues to push creative boundaries, using his lens to challenge perception and invite viewers to see the world more clearly through his eyes.
