

## **BRUCE KATSIFF**

Born in Philadelphia in 1945, Bruce Katsiff studied photography at Rochester Institute of Technology and Pratt Institute earning BFA and MFA degrees after graduating from Central High School. He completed postgraduate studies at Oxford University. His work has been exhibited in museums and galleries including the Museum of Modern Art in NYC, the Philadelphia Museum of Art, the Delaware Art Museum and the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Art. For 25 years he taught photography and was a college arts administrator. From 1989-2012, he served as Director/

CEO of the James A. Michener Art Museum in Bucks County. He also served as a peer accreditation and MAP reviewer for the American Alliance of Museums and taught in the graduate Museum Leadership program at Drexel University. He has served on many boards of cultural institutions and currently serves on the board of The Clay Studio and the Conservation Center for Art and Historic Artifacts. A major retrospective of his work opens in April 2026, with a new publication at the Michener Art Museum. Bruce and his wife Jo divide their time between a home and studio in New Jersey and an apartment in Philadelphia.
