Dr. Colleen Hooper is an Associate Professor of Dance and Director of Dance Education at Point Park University. Colleen is also a researcher, dancer, choreographer, educator, and arts administrator focused on how dance connects to economic and cultural transformations. She holds a Ph.D. and a MFA in Dance from Temple University's Boyer School of Music and Dance, and a Certificate in Community Arts Practices from Temple University's Tyler School of Art and

Architecture. Hooper served as the Press and Marketing Manager for five years at BAX/ Brooklyn Arts Exchange, and her choreography has been presented in a variety of site-specific and traditional stage venues since 2002. New York venues include Dance Theater Workshop's Fresh Tracks series (now New York Live Arts), Danspace Project Out of Space, Dixon Place, BRIC Studio, DanceNow/NYC Festival, BAX/Brooklyn Arts Exchange, Joyce SoHo, and Dance New Amsterdam. She serves as a board member for the Pennsylvania Dance Education Organization (PaDEO), and she serves on the editorial board of the peer-reviewed journal *Money on the Left*. Her research has been published in *Dance Research Journal*, *Feminist Modernist Studies*, the *International Journal of Screendance*, *Liminalities: A Journal of Performance Studies*, and *Dance: Current Selected Research*.
