

## FLASH ROSENBERG

Flash Rosenberg draws, photographs, writes, and performs. Founder of Flash Artists, a troupe of over 40 costumed artists who created interactive arts experiences and photo souvenirs for every conceivable kind of event. She is a Guggenheim Fellow, who served as the pioneering Artist-in-Residence for LIVE from the NY Public Library, where she drew conversations between authors, artists and provocateurs to create “portraits of ideas” in real-time. Her work is featured in the 2026 exhibit “Citizen Artist” curated by the Delaware Art Museum. She is a three-time, Mainstage Storyteller for The Moth. Creator of FlashThink Cartoons. Voted “Funniest Person in Philadelphia” in the 1990s by The City Paper for her public radio spots, “Flash Moments.” An Academy Award finalist for her experimental short “Pulse of Desire.” She taught “Perception Studies” classes for Cooper Union conducted entirely on the NYC subways. Flash Rosenberg Studio is a full-service art, motion picture, merriment, and mischief factory, based in Harlem. She lives with two turtles and infinite questions.
